


## What will we experience when our Lord comes?

God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus. 15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord (NASB; I Thess. 4:14b-17).

When our Lord comes (1) those of us asleep in Jesus will return with Him to be rejoined forever to our resurrected bodies, (2) those of us still living will be raptured with them to meet Him in the air, where (3) we all will be imperishably, immortally glorified when we see Him as He is.
