## Executions in the Tower

Ten prisoners were executed here on Tower Green. Seven were beheaded, including three queens: Catherine Howard (1542), Anne Boleyn, and Lady Jane Grey (1554). Three rebel soldiers were killed by firing squad.

Trois soldats rebelles furent fusillés par un peloton d'exécution. Généralement, les exécutions se déroulaient dans une salle à l'intérieur des murs de la Tour sur Tower Green.

Dziesięciu więźniów zostało straconych tutaj na Tower Green. Siedem z nich zostało ściętych, w tym trzy królowe: Katarzyna Howard (1542), Anna Boleyn oraz Lady Jane Grey. W tym miejscu został też stracony pluton buntowniczy. Na skwerze Tower Green wykonywane były także egzekucje więźniów o statusie specjalnym. Większość wyroków była wyznaczana na sądowniczym trybunale w wieżach (Tower Hall) na oczach ogromnego, szaryącego tłumu.

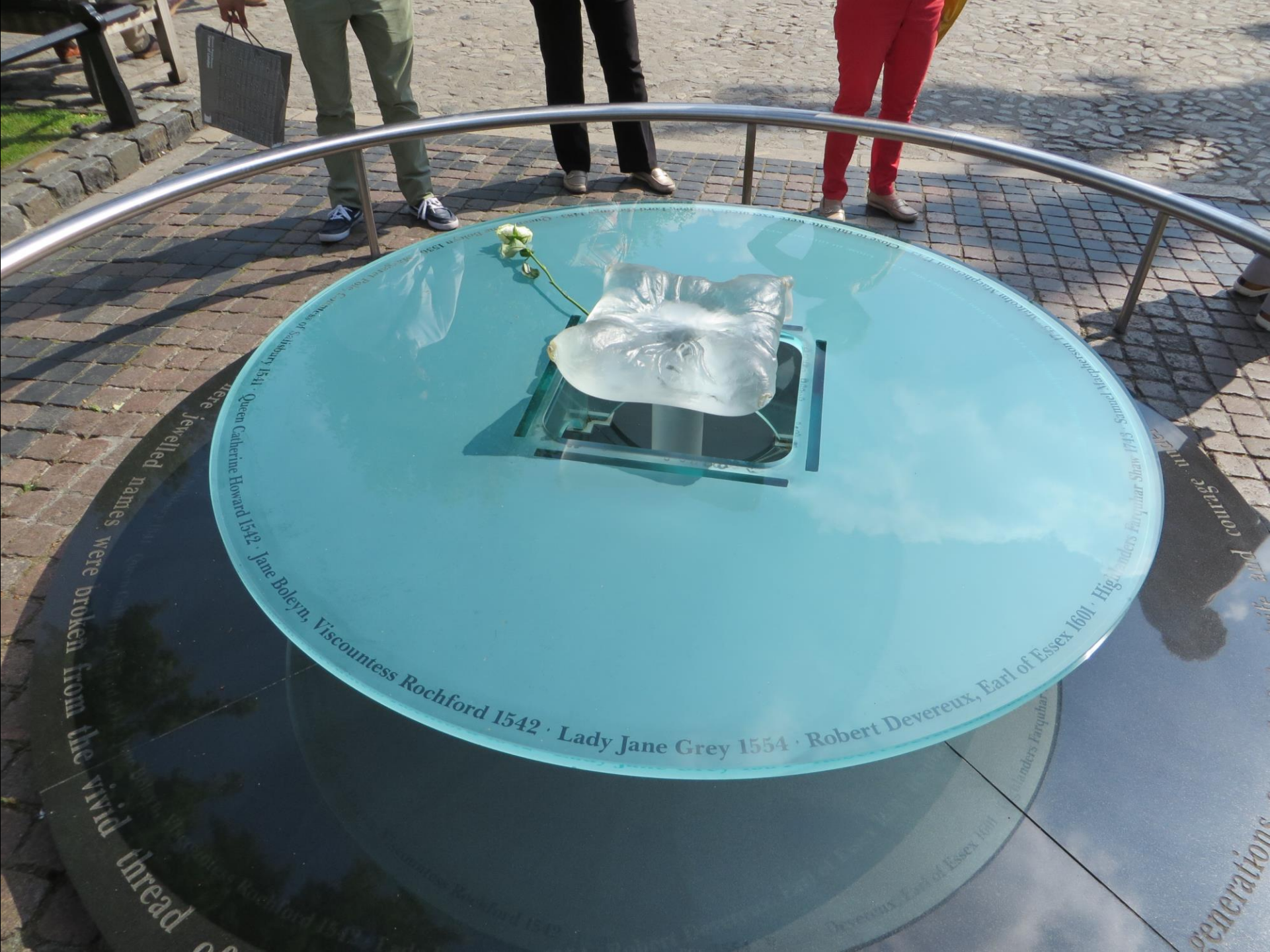
**Russian**

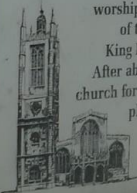


### St Margaret's Church Westminster Abbey

Visitors are welcome to this beautiful church. The present building, consecrated in 1523, is the third on the site. Since 1614 St Margaret's has been the church of the House of Commons.

Windows commemorate Caxton and Milton, who worshipped here, and Raleigh, who is buried in front of the altar, under the glorious window made for King Henry VIII and Catherine of Aragon in 1520. After about nine hundred years of service as a parish church for the people of Westminster, St Margaret's was placed under the care of the Dean and Chapter of Westminster by Parliament in 1873.

It is still in regular use for worship and for recitals of music.


