







Thus have I in few words written to you before I die. . . Because I desire that you may have the life laid up for all them that believe in the Lord Jesus and love one another when I am deceased.

(1) Simple, Sloth, and Presumption dead, hanging along the road. Mercy says, *let them hang*. Why?




