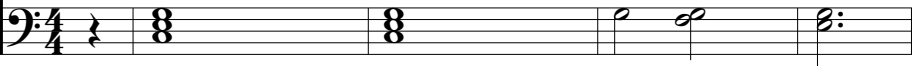


I Cry With My Whole Heart PSALM 119 T

4. O Lord, You con - tin - ue to be near to me;



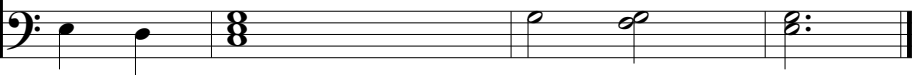
The things You com - mand I will do.
